

DEMOCRATIC PARTY OF LANE COUNTY

CENTRAL COMMITTEE MINUTES

6/18/2015 — Lokey Education Building, U.O., Eugene

The monthly meeting of the Democratic Party of Lane County Central Committee, held at the U.O. Lokey Education Complex on Thursday evening, June 18, 2015, was called to order at twenty one minutes past seven p.m., Mr. Wig being in the Chair and noting a quorum, and Ms. Swenson-Harris present as Secretary.

The agenda was adopted as distributed.

The minutes were approved as amended.

The Treasurer's Report was received. The Party had \$4,368 in income and \$3,774.90 in expenses during the previous month, with a net difference of \$593.10.

The Budget Committee reported that the year-to-date expenses have been \$15,919.90, and year-to-date income has been \$11,969.20, giving the Party a net loss of \$3,950.40 for fiscal year 2015.

Mr. Coatsworth reported that the Campaign Services Committee is organizing a Springfield Neighbourhood Leaders Programme.

The Community Action Committee reported that the Party will have entries in the Creswell 4th of July Parade and the Whitaker Block Party. The Chili Cook Off will be held on August 16. Ms. Heermance reported that volunteers are needed for the Lane County Fair booth.

The Fundraising Committee reported that a committee has been assembled to plan the

Roosevelt Dinner and that meetings will be held on Tuesdays at 6P.M.. Mr. Cronin recognized donors from the previous month.

The Organization Committee reported that the Florence Area Democrats have been working to reregister Democrats who have recently moved to Florence. Mr. Foster encouraged House District Chairs to make use of the funds budgeted for House District events.

The Organization Subcommittee for PCP's reported the name of one person requesting nomination for the position of Precinct Committee Person: Madison Hibler, who was nominated by Mr. Cronin and seconded. Mr. Cronin moved to appoint David Force and Kyle Warren to the position of Precinct Committee Person. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

Ms. Sundgrenz reported that the PR Committee is in the process of creating new buttons for the 2016 election.

The State Central Committee Delegation reported that an SCC meeting will be held on June 27 and 28.

The 4th CD Delegation reported that a meeting was held on June 7 in Coos Bay.

Mr. Wig and Ms. Gillpatrick reported on the recall petitions being circulated against Democratic Legislators. Lawn signs in support

of Representative Hoyle are available to residents of House District 14.

As new business, the Committee considered Resolution 2015.12. Mr. Foster moved to adopt the resolution. The motion was seconded by Mr. Cronin. Mr. Foster moved to strike and replace sections 1 and 2 of the resolution. The

motion was seconded by Ms. Fahey and passed unanimously. The resolution was adopted as amended.

Upon unanimous consent, the Chair adjourned the meeting at seventeen minutes past eight o'clock.
