## **Central Committee Minutes**

Nominations for PCP were Jane Marsh nominated by Matt Keating and seconded by Tim Morris, and Warren Higer nominated by Katrina Bowser and seconded by Laura Gilpatrick. Emily Keizer moved and Tim Morris seconded to

appoint Jerry Rosiek and Chandler James as PCPs, which passed unanimously.

House District 7 reported that they are planning a future meeting.

House District 8 reported that they met to get feedback on the recall election.

House District 12 reported that they are keeping an eye on the recall efforts currently happening in Cottage Grove.

House District 13 reported that the Ward 7 election is happening in the district and that they are working hard to help Lyndsie Leech.

House District 14 reported that they are working on getting new leadership positions.

The Platform Committee reported that plans are ongoing for the platform convention.

The PR Committee reported that they need people to add events for the calendar.
