The Fundraising Committee reported that the DEM Club is now up and running for monthly donors.

The Organization Committee reported the committee is meeting April 26th with a Neighborhood Leader training.

Nominations for PCP were Eric Nelson, nominated by Rebecca Bradvica and seconded by Elise Josephson. Brandon Oliver moved and Elise Josephson seconded to appoint Ife Adeniji, Kevin Cronin, and Theresa Fiora Starchild-Wolf as PCPs, which passed unanimously.
