A resolution of the Democratic Party of Lane County

Relating to the Vehicular Assault at June 28<sup>th</sup>'s BLM Children's March

**WHEREAS,** the peaceful expression of beliefs is central to a functioning democracy, and

**WHEREAS,** the Black Lives Matter movement is devoted to promoting a just and equitable society through peaceful protest, and

**WHEREAS,** on June 28 a peaceful children's march was hosted in Eugene in support of Black Lives Matter, and

WHEREAS, at that children's march a car ran through those gathered, and

**WHEREAS,** the driver of that vehicle was detained briefly before being released by EPD despite protestors being injured at the scene, and

**WHEREAS,** Black people continue to be targets of hatred and white supremacy in our community, and

**WHEREAS,** the Democratic Party of Lane County remains committed to peaceful expression and rooting out hatred and violence in our community

**THEREFORE,** the Democratic Party of Lane County resolves:

**SECTION 1:** Peaceful protest should always be respected.

**SECTION 2:** Whoever uses violence against peaceful protestors should be held accountable to the fullest extent of the law.
