RESOLUTION 2020.1

A resolution of the Democratic Party of Lane County

Relating to Urging Prosecution of Criminal Acts by the Trump Administration and formation of a Truth and Reconciliation Commission

WHEREAS, criminal behavior and violation of State and Federal law has allegedly occurred repeatedly under the administration of former President Donald Trump; and

WHEREAS, such alleged criminal acts include incitement to violent insurrection and other violence, pressuring public officials to subvert legal elections, malfeasance related to bounties paid by Russia for killing of American servicemen in the Middle East, Hatch Act violations, obstruction of justice including 10 counts found in the Mueller investigation, election interference including Post Office delivery manipulation, deaths and separation of migrant families, emoluments clause violations, payment of hush money, incitement of violence, negligent death in Hurricane Maria and the Covid epidemic, perjury (Roger Stone and Wikileaks testimony), rape, airstrikes in Syria and assassination of General Soleimani, federal and state tax evasion and loan fraud, bribery and witness intimidation; and

WHEREAS, there is an inability to "move forward" without an adequate examination of these alleged crimes and prosecution where such crimes have occurred; and

WHEREAS, the entirety of the Trump administration's alleged crimes cannot be examined without such investigations; and

WHEREAS, Congressman Eric Swalwell of California has called for a Presidential Crimes Commission to be formed,

THEREFORE, the Democratic Party of Lane County resolves To urge Democratic members of the US House of Representatives to:

SECTION 1: Support Swalwell's proposed Presidential Crimes Commission and to demand complete and thorough investigation and prosecution of Donald Trump and all members of his administration found reliably guilty of crimes and malfeasance;

SECTION 2: Insist on substantial monetary fines and incarceration to the fullest extent of the law;

SECTION 3: To investigate and provide compensatory damages or other remedies to the myriads of people damaged by these actions; and

SECTION 4: to begin the process to clarify and add additional laws and clarify fines and sentencing guidelines for future administrations to ensure that the norms of democratic society are respected in future administrations.
